



COVID-19 Health and Safety Measures - 7/09/2021

Key points	Actions
Maintaining personal hygiene practices	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Staff and students are to use common sense regarding safety measures for COVID-19. Good hygiene/public health posters displayed around the school. Hand sanitiser in all classrooms and shared spaces. Teachers apply sanitiser to all boys on entry into the classroom at the beginning of each lesson. Soap, water and the ability to dry hands provided in bathrooms - best practice. Classroom doors and entry/exit doors to be held back to avoid touching. Promotion of good hygiene practices via daily notices and posters. Masks are recommended but not compulsory.
Managing sickness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> School staff are to observe students on arrival into the classroom checking for symptoms and ask those presenting as unwell to go to the Sick Bay. Student Services to isolate people who display symptoms of COVID-19. If people are sick, they should stay home (phone Healthline or their GP).
Physical distancing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Boys and staff should be far enough away from each other so that they are not breathing on or touching each other. There does not need to be a specific measurement but where practicable 1m should be used as a guide, particularly between adults. Good hygiene practices and regular cleaning of commonly touched surfaces to take place.
Regular cleaning of surfaces	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> High use surfaces cleaned daily by Taranaki Associated Cleaners Shared supplies and equipment are able to be used if students and staff are undertaking regular hand washing and staying away if sick. Regular cleaning of shared equipment.
Visitors on site	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All visitors MUST sign in at the school office and supply details for contract tracing purposes. Physical distancing of 2 metres is recommended for parents and caregivers from people they don't know. School facilities to be closed after school for members of the public. Signs to be displayed.
Tuckshop	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Maximum of 8 in at a time, one in one out rule applies. A staff member must be present to let boys in. Boys must sanitise before entering.
Water fountains	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shared water fountains shut off to students. Boys are encouraged to bring a water bottle to fill at the taps available.
Mass gatherings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We are exempt from public mass gatherings guidelines, but where people are visiting school then these rules apply. Assemblies have been postponed until further notice.
Buses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> School transport will resume - school to provide a list of bus students to Transit.
Physical Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Physical education classes and break time activities have access to sports equipment and facilities, best hygiene practices apply. There will be regular cleaning of shared equipment such as balls, sticks etc.
Sport	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sports equipment use and activities can resume. Contact sports can resume. There are situations where physical distancing is not possible, such as some sporting activities. In these situations, extra emphasis on handwashing and drying (or cleansing with hand sanitiser) before and after activities and regular cleaning of equipment is required.
